Section 1. Section 28-419, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 28-419 No person shall induce or entice any person 4 to breathe, inhale, or drink any compound, liquid, or chemical 5 containing acetate, acetone, benzene, butyl alcohol, cyclohexanone, ethyl acetate, ethyl alcohol, ethylene dichloride, ethylene 6 7 trichloride, hexane, isopropanol, isopropyl alcohol, methyl 8 alcohol, methyl cellosolve acetate, methyl ethyl ketone, methyl isobutyl ketone, pentachlorophenol, petroleum ether, toluene, 9 10 toluol, trichloroathane, trichloroethylene, or any other substance 11 for the purpose of inducing a condition of intoxication, stupefaction, depression, giddiness, paralysis, inebriation, 12 13 excitement, or irrational behavior, or in any manner changing, 14 distorting, or disturbing the auditory, visual, mental, or nervous 15 processes. For the purposes of sections 28-419 to 28-424, any such 16 condition so induced shall be deemed an intoxicated condition.

Sec. 2. Original section 28-419, Reissue Revised Statutes
of Nebraska, is repealed.
