1 FOR AN ACT relating to audiovisual court appearances; to amend
2 section 29-4206, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
3 2006; to remove a requirement of consent and waiver of
4 physical appearance as prescribed; to repeal the original
5 section; and to outright repeal section 29-4203, Revised
6 Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2006.
7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 29-4206, Revised Statutes Cumulative
2 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:

3 29-4206 The district courts may accept a written waiver
4 of arraignment and plea of not guilty from any defendant. The form
5 shall ~~contain the necessary consent and waiver of the right to a~~
6 ~~physical appearance,~~ shall be signed by the defendant and his or
7 her counsel of record, if any, and shall be filed with the clerk of
8 the court.
