A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to courts; to amend section 24-201.01,  
2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2006; to increase  
3 the salaries of Supreme Court judges as prescribed;  
4 to provide an operative date; to repeal the original  
5 section; and to declare an emergency.  
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. Section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative  
2 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:

3           24-201.01 ~~On July 1, 2002, the salary of the Chief~~  
4 ~~Justice and judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred~~  
5 ~~nineteen thousand two hundred seventy-six dollars. On July 1, 2005,~~  
6 ~~the salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court~~  
7 ~~shall be one hundred twenty-two thousand eight hundred fifty-four~~  
8 ~~dollars. On July 1, 2006, the salary of the Chief Justice and~~  
9 ~~the judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred twenty-six~~  
10 ~~thousand eight hundred forty-six dollars. On July 1, 2007, the~~  
11 salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court  
12 shall be XXX dollars. On July 1, 2008, the salary of the Chief  
13 Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall be XXX dollars.

14           The Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court  
15 shall hold no other public office of profit or trust during their  
16 terms of office nor accept any public appointment or employment  
17 under the authority of the government of the United States for  
18 which they receive compensation for their services. Such salaries  
19 shall be payable in equal monthly installments.

20           Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2007.

21           Sec. 3. Original section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes  
22 Cumulative Supplement, 2006, is repealed.

23           Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect  
24 when passed and approved according to law.
