A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to interior design; to adopt the Interior
- Designers Certification Act; and to provide an operative
- 3 date.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as

- 2 the Interior Designers Certification Act.
- 3 Sec. 2. For purposes of the Interior Designers
- 4 Certification Act:
- 5 (1) Board means the Board of Interior Designers;
- 6 (2) Interior design means the programming, study,
- 7 consultation, drawing, specification, and administration of a
- 8 <u>design construction contract relating to nonstructural interior</u>
- 9 elements of a building or structure. Interior design includes,
- 10 but is not limited to, space planning, selection of materials and
- 11 finishes, selection and specification of furniture, fixtures, and
- 12 equipment, and preparation of construction documents. Interior
- 13 design does not include the practice of architecture as defined
- 14 in section 81-3420 or the practice of engineering as defined in
- 15 section 81-3421; and
- 16 (3) Certified interior designer means a person who is a
- 17 certified design professional qualified by education, examination,
- 18 or experience as prescribed by the act.
- 19 Sec. 3. (1) The Board of Interior Designers is created
- 20 to administer the Interior Designers Certification Act. The board
- 21 may use any funds available to obtain suitable office space within
- 22 Lincoln, Nebraska. The board shall consist of:
- (a) Four members who are certified under the act,
- 24 appointed by the Governor, after consultation with professional
- 25 associations or societies composed of interior designers; and

1 (b) One	public member	appointed by	y the Governor.
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- 2 (2) Of the initial members, two shall be appointed for
- 3 one-year terms, two for two-year terms, and one for a three-year
- 4 term. All members thereafter shall be appointed for three-year
- 5 terms. Each initial member appointed under subdivision (1)(a) of
- 6 this section shall become certified within one year after his
- 7 or her appointment. If he or she fails to become certified, the
- 8 Governor shall remove such member and appoint a replacement for the
- 9 unexpired term. All members thereafter appointed under subdivision
- 10 (1)(a) of this section shall be certified. Each member shall hold
- 11 office after the expiration of his or her term until his or her
- 12 successor is duly appointed and qualified. The Governor may remove
- 13 any member of the board for misconduct, incompetency, or neglect of
- 14 duty. Vacancies in the membership of the board, however created,
- 15 shall be filled for the unexpired term by appointment by the
- 16 Governor.
- 17 (3) Each member of the board shall be reimbursed for
- 18 his or her actual and necessary expenses as provided in sections
- 19 81-1174 to 81-1177.
- 20 Sec. 4. The duties of the board shall include, but are
- 21 not limited to, the following:
- 22 (1) Administering and enforcing the Interior Designers
- 23 Certification Act;
- 24 (2) Adopting a code of ethics;
- 25 (3) Establishing requirements for the examination,

1 education, and practical training of applicants for certification;

- 2 (4) Adopting and promulgating rules and regulations to
- 3 carry out the act;
- 4 (5) Establishing fees for certification, renewal of
- 5 certification, reinstatement of certification, and for other
- 6 activities of the board pertaining to its duties. Such fees shall
- 7 be sufficient to defray the costs of administering the act and
- 8 shall be not less than one hundred nor more than three hundred
- 9 dollars for initial certification, renewal of certification, and
- 10 reinstatement of certification;
- 11 (6) Establishing standards and requirements of continuing
- 12 education as a prerequisite to renewal of certification;
- 13 <u>(7) Maintaining a complete roster of all certified</u>
- 14 interior designers. The roster shall be filed with the Secretary of
- 15 State; and
- 16 (8) Maintaining records of the board's proceedings which
- 17 are open to public inspection at all reasonable times relating
- 18 to the issuance, refusal, renewal, suspension, and revocation of
- 19 certification.
- 20 Sec. 5. (1) Each applicant for certification shall meet
- 21 the interior design education and practical training requirements
- 22 adopted by the board and shall pass an examination approved by
- 23 the board that is task-oriented, focused on public safety, and
- 24 validated by a recognized testing agency. The board shall certify
- 25 an individual who submits an application to the board on the form

1 and in the manner prescribed by the board as an interior designer

- 2 if the individual satisfies the following requirements:
- 3 (a) Submits written proof that the individual has
- 4 successfully passed the National Council for Interior Design
- 5 Qualification examination or its equivalent;
- 6 (b) Submits written proof of completion of four years
- 7 of design education in interior design from a Council for
- 8 Interior Design Accreditation accredited program or a substantially
- 9 equivalent program approved by the board;
- 10 (c) Submits written proof of a minimum of two years of
- 11 full-time work experience in interior design;
- 12 (d) Submits a copy of the code of ethics adopted by the
- 13 board and signed by the individual; and
- 14 (e) Submits the required certification fee to the board.
- 15 (2) The board shall grant certification by reciprocity.
- 16 An applicant applying to the board for certification by reciprocity
- 17 shall furnish satisfactory evidence that the applicant meets both
- 18 of the following requirements:
- 19 (a) He or she holds a valid certification, registration,
- 20 or license issued by another authority recognized by the board
- 21 where the qualifications for certification, registration, or
- 22 licensure are substantially equivalent to those prescribed in this
- 23 state on the date of application under this subsection; and
- 24 (b) He or she holds a valid certificate number issued by
- 25 the National Council for Interior Design Qualification.

1 (3) The board shall grant certification to an architect

- 2 licensed pursuant to the Engineers and Architects Regulation Act.
- 3 (4) When an applicant under subsection (1), (2), or
- 4 (3) of this section has complied with the qualifications for
- 5 certification to the satisfaction of a majority of the board
- 6 members and submitted the fees prescribed by the board, the
- 7 board shall record the applicant's name and address in the roster
- 8 of certified interior designers and issue to the applicant a
- 9 certificate signed by the members of the board and valid for one
- 10 year. The certificate shall entitle the applicant to use the title
- 11 of certified interior designer in this state.
- 12 Sec. 6. A certified interior designer shall, at the
- 13 time of application for renewal of certification, submit proof of
- 14 completion of continuing education requirements established by the
- 15 board and shall submit the fee established by the board in section
- 16 4 of this act.
- Sec. 7. (1) The board may revoke, suspend, or refuse to
- 18 issue or renew a certificate of any person upon a finding of any of
- 19 the following:
- 20 (a) Fraud in obtaining or renewing certification;
- 21 (b) Violation of the code of ethics adopted by the board
- 22 under the Interior Designers Certification Act;
- (c) Violation of the Engineers and Architects Regulation
- 24 Act by engaging in the practice of architecture or the practice of
- 25 <u>engineering;</u>

1 (d) Conviction of a felony related to the profession or

- 2 occupation of the certified interior designer. A copy of the record
- 3 of conviction or plea of guilty shall be conclusive evidence of the
- 4 conviction;
- 5 (e) Unlawful use of the title of certified interior
- 6 designer; or
- 7 (f) Violation of the Interior Designers Certification Act
- 8 or a rule or regulation adopted and promulgated by the board under
- 9 the act.
- 10 (2) Any person may appeal a finding of the board within
- 11 thirty days after the date of notification of the action. Such
- 12 appeal shall be in accordance with the Administrative Procedure
- 13 Act.
- 14 Sec. 8. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to use
- 15 the title of certified interior designer or any title or device
- 16 <u>indicating that the person is a certified interior designer unless</u>
- 17 the person has been issued a certificate under the act. This
- 18 subsection does not prohibit the use of the terms interior design
- 19 or interior designer or the performance of interior design services
- 20 by a person who is not certified as an interior designer.
- 21 (2) Any person who violates this section is guilty of a
- 22 Class V misdemeanor. In addition to any other remedies under the
- 23 Interior Designers Certification Act and on petition of the board,
- 24 any person who violates this section may be permanently enjoined
- 25 from continuing such violation.

Sec. 9. (1) Beginning on the operative date of this act 1 2 and through December 31, 2011, the board may issue an interior 3 designer certificate to a person residing in Nebraska who does not 4 meet the requirements listed in section 5 of this act if the person 5 (a) submits the fee prescribed in subdivision (1)(e) of section 5 6 of this act and written proof of fifteen years of work experience 7 deemed satisfactory by the board or (b) submits written proof to the board of successful completion of Section I of the National 9 Council for Interior Design Qualification examination relating to 10 life safety codes and barrier-free requirements and the following: 11 (i) An accredited baccalaureate degree, a diploma, or a 12 certificate from a program with a minimum of sixty credit hours in 13 interior design coursework; and 14 (ii) A combination of six years of education and work 15 experience deemed satisfactory by the board. (2) A person who is issued a certificate under this 16 17 section shall not be required to meet the requirements of section 5 18 of this act to obtain subsequent renewals of such certificate. 19 Sec. 10. Fees received pursuant to the act shall be 20 remitted by the board to the State Treasurer for credit to the 21 Interior Designers Certification Cash Fund which is hereby created. 22 The fund shall be used to defray the cost of administering the Interior Designers Certification Act. Any money in the fund 23 24 available for investment shall be invested by the state investment 25 officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the

- 1 Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.
- 2 Sec. 11. This act becomes operative on January 1, 2009.
