A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Probate Code; to amend section  
2 30-2483, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide  
3 for notice of appointment of a personal representative as  
4 prescribed; and to repeal the original section.  
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. Section 30-2483, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3           30-2483 (1) Unless notice has already been given under  
4 this article and except when an appointment of a personal  
5 representative is made pursuant to subdivision (4) of section  
6 30-2408, the clerk of the court upon the appointment of a  
7 personal representative shall publish a notice once a week for  
8 three successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in  
9 the county announcing the appointment and the address of the  
10 personal representative, and notifying creditors of the estate to  
11 present their claims within two months after the date of the  
12 first publication of the notice or be forever barred. The first  
13 publication shall be made within thirty days after the appointment.  
14 The party instituting or maintaining the proceeding or his or her  
15 attorney is required to mail the published notice and give proof  
16 thereof in accordance with section 25-520.01.

17           (2) For all decedents fifty-five years of age or  
18 older or who resided in a medical institution as defined in  
19 subdivision (1)(b) of section 68-919, not later than fourteen  
20 days after appointment of a personal representative other than  
21 a special administrator, the personal representative shall give  
22 written notice of his or her appointment to the Department  
23 of Health and Human Services. The notice shall include the  
24 decedent's name and social security number and, if available  
25 upon reasonable investigation, the name and social security number

1 of the decedent's spouse if such spouse is deceased, but the notice  
2 need not include a copy of the decedent's will.
