Section 1. Section 32-712, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

LB 857

3 32-712 At least sixty days Not later than September 8 prior to any general election at which candidates for President 4 and Vice President of the United States are to be voted upon 5 6 by the registered voters of the state, the appropriate officers 7 of the various national political party conventions shall certify 8 the names and addresses of such candidates selected by convention 9 to the Secretary of State. The Secretary of State shall then 10 take appropriate steps to place the names of the presidential and 11 vice-presidential candidates on the ballot.

Sec. 2. Original section 32-712, Reissue Revised Statutes
of Nebraska, is repealed.
