Section 1. Section 60-301, Revised Statutes Supplement,

- 8 60-3,134 Any motor vehicle or trailer that qualifies as
- 9 an historical vehicle which is used for the same general purposes
- 10 and under the same conditions as motor vehicles or trailers
- 11 registered with regular license plates shall be required to be
- 12 registered with regular license plates or use plates provided for
- 13 in section 3 of this act, regardless of its age, and shall be
- 14 subject to the payment of the same taxes and fees required of motor
- 15 vehicles or trailers registered with regular license plates.
- 16 Sec. 3. (1) An owner of a historical vehicle eligible
- for registration under section 60-3,130 may use a license plate
- 18 or plates designed by this state in the year corresponding to the
- 19 model year when the vehicle was manufactured in lieu of regular
- 20 license plates otherwise required pursuant to section 60-3,134
- 21 subject to the approval of the department. The department shall
- 22 inspect the plate or plates and may approve the plate or plates if
- 23 it is determined that the model-year license plate or plates are
- 24 <u>legible</u> and serviceable and that the license plate numbers do not
- 25 conflict with or duplicate other numbers assigned and in use. An

1 original-issued license plate or plates that have been restored to

- 2 original condition may be used when approved by the department.
- 3 (2) The department may consult with a recognized car club
- 4 in determining whether the year of the license plate or plates
- 5 to be used corresponds to the model year when the vehicle was
- 6 manufactured.
- 7 (3) If only one license plate is used on the vehicle, the
- 8 license plate shall be placed on the rear of the vehicle. The owner
- 9 of a historical vehicle may use only one plate on the vehicle even
- 10 for years in which two license plates were issued for vehicles in
- 11 general.
- 12 (4) License plates used pursuant to this section
- 13 corresponding to the year of manufacture of the vehicle shall
- 14 <u>not be personalized message license plates, Pearl Harbor license</u>
- 15 plates, prisoner-of-war license plates, disabled veteran license
- 16 plates, Purple Heart license plates, amateur radio station license
- 17 plates, Nebraska Cornhusker Spirit Plates, or handicapped or
- 18 disabled person license plates.
