#### A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to natural resources districts; to amend section 2-3235, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2006; to limit the authority of districts as prescribed;
- 4 and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 2-3235, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:
- 3 2-3235 (1) Each district shall have the power and
- 4 authority to cooperate with or to enter into agreements with
- 5 and, within the limits of appropriations available, to furnish
- 6 financial or other aid to any cooperator, any agency, governmental
- 7 or otherwise, or any owner or occupier of lands within the district
- 8 for the carrying out of projects for benefit of the district as
- 9 authorized by law, subject to such conditions as the board may deem
- 10 necessary. This section shall not be construed to give a district
- 11 the power or authority to cooperate with or enter into agreements
- 12 with, or to furnish financial or other aid to, any person who is
- 13 in the business of selling or leasing, offering for sale or lease,
- 14 or advertising for sale or lease, residential or commercial real
- 15 property, when the cooperation, agreement, or financial or other
- 16 aid relates to real property taken by the district through the use
- of eminent domain under section 2-3234.
- 18 (2) As a condition to the extending of any benefits to
- 19 or the performance of work upon any lands not owned or controlled
- 20 by this state or any of its agencies, the directors may require
- 21 contributions in money, services, materials, or otherwise to any
- 22 operations conferring such benefits and may require landowners to
- 23 enter into and perform such agreements or covenants as to the
- 24 permanent use of such lands as will tend to prevent or control
- 25 erosion thereon.

1 (3) Each district may make available, on such terms as

- 2 it shall prescribe, to landowners within the district specialized
- 3 equipment, materials, and services which are not readily available
- 4 from other sources and which will assist such landowners to carry
- 5 on operations upon their lands for the conservation of soil and
- 6 water resources and for the prevention and control of soil erosion.
- 7 Whenever reasonably possible, purchases or contracts for such
- 8 equipment shall be made from retail establishments.
