The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The purpose of this bill is to increase the likelihood that sibling groups will have the ability to attend the same school(s), so long as their enrollment in said school(s) is in the best interest of each child.

LB1005 would change the requirements for the provisions within the community coordinating council's diversity plan defined in 79-2110 to include first siblings of students currently enrolled in a school building as a specific limitation to the open enrollment criteria.
