

Hundredth Legislature - Second Session - 2008 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 714

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 714 reduces state and local taxes in two ways.

- 1. The bill exempts income received from social security benefits when determining state individual income tax liability. This provision would apply to income earned in 2008 and after.
- 2. The bill exempts social security income from the calculations used to determine eligibility for a homestead exemption which will in turn lower the property tax liability on homesteads for persons who receive social security. This provision applies to individuals who apply for a homestead exemption in 2009 and after.
