FINAL READING: CONSENT CALENDAR (BILLS PRECEDED WITH AN * WILL REQUIRE A VOTE TO SUSPEND AT LARGE READING, PURSUANT TO RULE 6, SECTION 8)

The following rules apply to Consent Calendar:

- 1) If any three members of the Legislature object to the bill being considered on Consent Calendar, please advise the Clerk in writing. Such requests must be filed with the Clerk prior to the expiration of 15 minutes of debate, at this stage of consideration, on the bill to be removed.
- 2) Upon either the completion of debate or the expiration of 15 minutes, whichever comes first, a vote shall be taken to advance the bill and on any pending motions or amendments pursuant to Rule 5, Section 6(d).
- 3) Any amendment adopted, other than the standing committee amendment, which adds new subject matter to the bill will result in the bill not being scheduled at the next stage of debate.

LB 411 (*Giese*) Update the references to the National Electrical Code in the State Electrical Act

LB 695e (*Price*) Change the jurisdictional amount of the Small Claims Court

LB 696 (*Pahls, Langemeier*) Change provisions relating to disposal fees under the Integrated Solid Waste Management Act

LB 706 (*Haar*) Provide fees for competency assessments of hearing interpreters

LB 713 (*Gloor*) Change provisions relating to school health inspections and authorize health data sharing

LB 732 (*Utter*) Change provisions relating to certain forced sales of real property

LB 758 (*Wightman*) Change provisions relating to doctrines of cy pres and deviation and powers of personal representatives

LB 759 (*Wightman*) Provide for the dissolution, winding up, and liquidation of certain professional corporations

*LB 760 (*Wightman*) Change provisions relating to total return trusts

LB 789 (*Ashford*) Change grant limits under the Local Civic, Cultural, and Convention Center Financing Act

*LB 792 (*Coash*) Change controlled substances schedules

LB 809 (*Rogert*) Change statute of limitations for fraud involving certain assistance programs

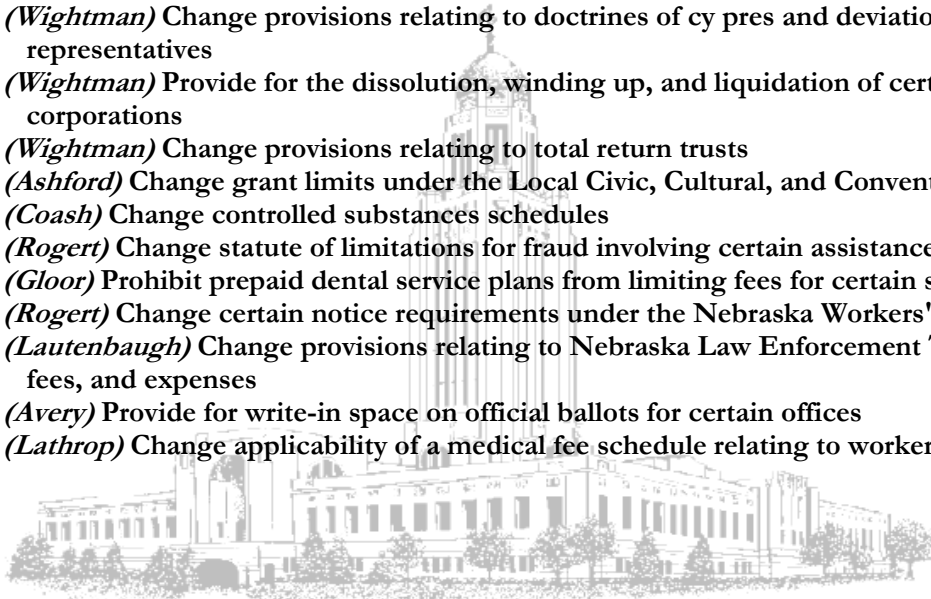
LB 813 (*Gloor*) Prohibit prepaid dental service plans from limiting fees for certain services

LB 829e (*Rogert*) Change certain notice requirements under the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act

LB 844 (*Lautenbaugh*) Change provisions relating to Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center tuition, fees, and expenses

LB 852 (*Avery*) Provide for write-in space on official ballots for certain offices

LB 872 (*Lathrop*) Change applicability of a medical fee schedule relating to workers' compensation



- LB 884 *(McGill)* Require employers to provide employees with wage and deduction information as prescribed
- LB 894 *(Pirsch)* Change provisions relating to shoplifting and prohibit possession of any store security device countermeasure
- LB 907 *(Conrad)* Change provisions relating to homestead property exempt from execution
