Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Legislative Bill 1085 would amend statute section 25-1011 to clarify language and remove unnecessary language. The bill would also extend the time, from three days to seven days after the issuance of an order of garnishment, within which the judgment creditor must send to the judgment debtor the following: a copy of the summons and order of garnishment, a notice to judgment debtor form and a request for hearing form.
