## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Legislative Bill 163 would amend section $79-544$ to enable substitute teachers to be employed by a district while serving on its school board. Statute currently prohibits a school board member from being employed as a teacher in the school district he or she serves as a board member.

## Explanation of amendments:

The committee amendment strikes the original sections and becomes the bill. The amendment would prohibit a teacher under contract with a school district from serving as a member of its school board. The amendment would enable substitute teachers to serve as school board members, to the extent that they are not under contract with the district.
