## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 291 changes provisions of the Developmental Disabilities Services Act (sections 83-1201 to 83-1226). The bill requires the Director of the Division of Developmental Disabilities to provide "appropriate oversight regarding the safety, care, and habilitation of individuals that receive services through publicly funded community-based developmental disabilities services."

The bill requires the Department of Health and Human Services to "adopt and promulgate initial rules and regulations with regard to the safety, care, and habilitation of individuals receiving services through publicly funded community-based developmental disabilities services no later then September 1, 2009."

The bill contains an emergency clause.
