Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Legislative Bill 343 would amend Sec. 24-819 to establish a specific end date for the term of office (1) of a judge who loses a retention election, and (2) of a judge who fails to file with the Secretary of State an indication, as required by law, of his or her desire to stand for retention in office.

The specific end date would be the first Thursday after the first Tuesday in January next succeeding the retention election required by Sec. 24-814.
