The bill would also expand application of the statute from claims of up to \$2,000 to claims of up to \$4,000. **Explanation of amendments:** Committee Amendment AM 924 would allow the plaintiff to waive an award of court costs following a voluntary payment to the plaintiff by or on behalf of the defendant before a judgment is entered.
