Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 384 authorizes the release of a digital image or digital signature to a federal civil enforcement agency.

Current law prohibits the DMV or law enforcement officer from releasing the information except to a federal, state, or local law enforcement agency, or other state driver licensing agency. The bill adds to the exception a federal civil enforcement agency.
