## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 636 as introduced during the 2009 Legislative session, appropriates \$500,000 to the Department of Economic Development to provide funding for promotional and visitor activities related to the hosting of the U.S. Senior Open.

## **Explanation of amendments:**

The amendment to LB 636 strikes the existing sections and become the bill. It amends Section 66-1519 to allow for a \$300,000 grant to be made to a city of the metropolitan class from the Petroleum Release Remedial Action Cash Fund no later than September 15, 2010. The purpose of the grant would be to carry out the federal Residential Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction Act of 1992, Title X, Section 1011, Public Law 102-550. The amendment also removes obsolete language from Section 66-1519.
