Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Amends section 53-125 and section 53-103 by clarifying that a manager of a corporation with a liquor license shall be a citizen and resident. Currently, there are two references to "manager" in the Liquor Control Act that seem to contradict whether a manager is required to be a citizen and a resident. The Liquor Control Commission prefers this requirement.
