Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Amends the Wage Payment Act to allow an employee to request from the employer, an itemized pay stub. If the statement is not provided, an employee may file an injunction and receive attorney%u2019s fees if an injunction is ordered.

Section 1: Within 10 working days of an employee%u2019s request, an employer must provide an itemized pay statement including wages earned and deductions made for every pay period which deductions were made. Allows the statement to be in written or electronic form.

Section 2: An employee who does not receive the requested itemized statement may bring an injunction action and reasonable attorney%u2019s fees associated with initiating the action.

Section 3: Makes technical changes to section 48-1232 to comport with LB 884.

Section 4: repealer.

Explanation of amendments:

The committee amendment makes three changes: 1) the request must be in writing, (2) the employer has the choice of

whether to provide a print or electronic pay statement and (3) violation subjects the employer to an infraction rather than a suit for injunction.
