Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 999 states that the Division of Public Health of the Department of Health and Human Services shall not accept an application, or issue a license, for a new hospital beginning on September 1, 2010 and continuing through August 31, 2012; except that this prohibition shall not apply to an application for a license as a critical access hospital.
