LB 1032 would allow natural resources districts that have received a preliminary or final determination of full appropriation status, and a status change occurs according to section 46-714, the power to levy the tax that districts designated as fully or overappropriated are authorized to carry out under 2-3225. The impact to individual districts would depend upon governing board decisions.
