A BILL

1	FOR AN ACT relating to claims against the state; to appropriate
2	funds for the payment of certain claims; to provide for
3	payment of the claims; to authorize agencies to write
4	off certain claims as prescribed; and to declare an
5	emergency.

6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1	Section 1. The following sums of money, or so much
2	thereof as may be required, are hereby appropriated from the
3	General Fund or from other funds as indicated in the state
4	treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for the payment of tort
5	claims which have been settled by the State Claims Board and
6	approved by the district court, which have been settled by the
7	Attorney General in the district court, or in which court judgments
8	have been entered and which require the approval of the Legislature
9	for payment.
10	\$145,000.00 for Tort Claim Numbers 02-591, 02-592,
11	02-593, 02-594, 02-595, and 02-596, against the Department of
12	Health and Human Services, pay \$45,000.00 to Harris Kuhn Law Firm,

8	authorized and directed to draw his or her warrants upon the
9	funds in the state treasury enumerated in this act, in favor of

10 the several beneficiaries named in this act for the amount set 11 opposite their respective names upon the presentation of proper 12 vouchers therefor. The several amounts appropriated in this act 13 shall be in full payment of any and all claims, rights, causes 14 of action, damages, and demands of every character and kind owing 15 by or against the State of Nebraska, its officers, agents, and 16 employees, and their successors and assigns with respect to each 17 of the beneficiaries respectively in whose favor the appropriations 18 are made. The director shall not deliver any warrant for any 19 items appropriated in this act until a receipt and release in 20 full, releasing the State of Nebraska, its officers, employees, and 21 agents, and their successors and assigns, has been filed by each of 22 the beneficiaries respectively. Upon presentation of the warrants, 23 the State Treasurer is hereby directed to pay the same out of money 24 in the General Fund or out of money in other funds indicated in 25 this act not otherwise appropriated.
