A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Livestock Brand Act; to amend section
2 54-1,100, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
3 provisions relating to recorded brands; to change a fee;
4 and to repeal the original section.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 54-1,100, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 54-1,100 A recorded brand is the property of the person
4 causing such record to be made and is subject to sale, assignment,
5 transfer, devise, and descent as personal property. Instruments
6 Any instrument of writing evidencing the sale, assignment, or
7 transfer of a recorded brand shall be rerecorded by effective upon
8 its recording with the Nebraska Brand Committee. No such instrument
9 shall be accepted for recording if the brand committee has been
10 duly notified of the existence of a lien or security interest
11 against livestock owned or thereafter acquired by the owner of such
12 brand by the holder of such lien or security interest. Written
13 notification from the holder of such lien or security interest that
14 the lien or security interest has been satisfied or consent from
15 the holder of such lien or security interest shall be required in
16 order for the brand committee to accept for recording an instrument
17 selling, assigning, or transferring such recorded brand. The fee
18 for recording such an instrument shall be established by the brand
19 committee and shall not be more than thirty-five forty dollars.
20 Such instruments instrument shall give notice to all third persons
21 of the matter recorded in the instruments instrument and shall
22 be acknowledged by a notary public or any other officer qualified
23 under law to administer oaths.
