- 8 through June 30, 2012; and FY2012-13 means the period July 1, 2012,
- 9 through June 30, 2013.
- 10 Sec. 2. APPROPRIATION LANGUAGE.
- 11 There are hereby appropriated, for FY2009-10 and
- 12 FY2010-11, the sums set forth in this act to each agency for each
- 13 program from the respective funds for the general operations of
- 14 state government, postsecondary education, capital construction,
- 15 and state aid, except as otherwise appropriated.
- 16 Sec. 3. REAPPROPRIATION OF BALANCE, FY2009-10 to
- 17 FY2010-11.
- 18 In addition to the appropriations set forth in this
- 19 act, there are hereby reappropriated all unexpended appropriation
- 20 balances existing on June 30, 2010, for FY2010-11 to the respective
- 21 agencies, programs, and funds listed in this act, except as
- 22 otherwise provided in this act.
- Sec. 4. CERTIFIED ENCUMBRANCES.
- 24 <u>All certified encumbrance amounts on June 30, 2010, not</u>
- 25 otherwise reappropriated pursuant to section 3 of this act, are

1 hereby reappropriated for FY2010-11, which amounts shall be in

- 2 addition to the amounts shown in this act.
- 3 Sec. 5. NEBRASKA ACCOUNTING SYSTEM MANUAL DEFINITIONS.
- 4 The definitions contained in the Nebraska Accounting
- 5 System Manual, and any amendments thereto, on file with the Clerk
- 6 of the Legislature are hereby adopted by the Legislature as the
- 7 definitions for this act, except as provided in section 70 of this

- 9 Sec. 6. DRAWING AND PAYING WARRANTS.
