### A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to postsecondary education; to amend section

  85-502, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change

  and eliminate provisions relating to residency; to

  provide for applicability; and to repeal the original

  section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 85-502, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 85-502 Rules and regulations established by the governing
- 4 board of each state postsecondary educational institution shall
- 5 require as a minimum that a person is not deemed to have
- 6 established a residence in this state, for purposes of sections
- 7 85-501 to 85-504, unless such person is lawfully present in the
- 8 United States and:
- 9 (1) Such person is of legal age or is an emancipated
- 10 minor and has established a home in Nebraska where he or she
- 11 is habitually present for a minimum period of one hundred eighty
- 12 days, with the bona fide intention of making this state his or her
- 13 permanent residence, supported by documentary proof;
- 14 (2) The parents, parent, or guardian having custody of a
- 15 minor registering in the educational institution have established
- 16 a home in Nebraska where such parents, parent, or guardian are
- 17 or is habitually present with the bona fide intention to make
- 18 this state their, his, or her permanent residence, supported by
- 19 documentary proof. If a student has matriculated in any state
- 20 postsecondary educational institution while his or her parents,
- 21 parent, or guardian had an established home in this state, and the
- 22 parents, parent, or guardian ceases to reside in the state, such
- 23 student shall not thereby lose his or her resident status if such
- 24 student has the bona fide intention to make this state his or her
- 25 permanent residence, supported by documentary proof;

1 (3) Such student is of legal age and is a dependent for

- 2 federal income tax purposes of a parent or former guardian who
- 3 has established a home in Nebraska where he or she is habitually
- 4 present with the bona fide intention of making this state his or
- 5 her permanent residence, supported by documentary proof;
- 6 (4) Such student is a nonresident of this state prior
- 7 to marriage and marries a person who has established a home in
- 8 Nebraska where he or she is habitually present with the bona fide
- 9 intention of making this state his or her permanent residence,
- 10 supported by documentary proof;
- 11 (5) Except as provided in subdivision (8) of this
- 12 section, such Such student, if an alien, has applied to or
- 13 has a petition pending with the United States Immigration and
- 14 Naturalization Service to attain lawful status under federal
- 15 immigration law and has established a home in Nebraska for a
- 16 period of at least one hundred eighty days where he or she is
- 17 habitually present with the bona fide intention to make this state
- 18 his or her permanent residence, supported by documentary proof;
- 19 (6) Such student is a staff member or a dependent of a
- 20 staff member of the University of Nebraska, one of the Nebraska
- 21 state colleges, or one of the community college areas who joins
- 22 the staff immediately prior to the beginning of a term from an
- 23 out-of-state location; or
- 24 (7) Such student is on active duty with the armed
- 25 services of the United States and has been assigned a permanent

1 duty station in Nebraska, or is a legal dependent of a person on

- 2 active duty with the armed services of the United States assigned a
- 3 permanent duty station in Nebraska. + or
- 4 (8)(a) Such student resided with his or her parent,
- 5 guardian, or conservator while attending a public or private high
- 6 school in this state and:
- 7 (i) Graduated from a public or private high school in
- 8 this state or received the equivalent of a high school diploma in
- 9 this state;
- 10 (ii) Resided in this state for at least three years
- 11 before the date the student graduated from the high school or
- 12 received the equivalent of a high school diploma;
- 13 (iii) Registered as an entering student in a state
- 14 postsecondary educational institution not earlier than the 2006
- 15 fall semester; and
- 16 (iv) Provided to the state postsecondary educational
- 17 institution an affidavit stating that he or she will file
- 18 an application to become a permanent resident at the earliest
- 19 opportunity he or she is eligible to do so.
- 20 (b) If the parent, guardian, or conservator with whom the
- 21 student resided ceases to reside in the state, such student shall
- 22 not lose his or her resident status under this subdivision if the
- 23 student has the bona fide intention to make this state his or her
- 24 permanent residence, supported by documentary proof.
- 25 The changes made to this section by this legislative bill

1 shall not apply to any student enrolled in a state postsecondary

- 2 educational institution on September 1, 2010, or to any student
- 3 enrolled in grade twelve in a high school in Nebraska on September
- 4 1, 2010.
- 5 The changes made to this section by this legislative
- 6 bill shall not apply to any student in Nebraska on and after
- 7 the effective or operative date of any federal legislation which
- 8 preempts such changes.
- 9 Sec. 2. Original section 85-502, Reissue Revised Statutes
- 10 of Nebraska, is repealed.
