A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to provide a definition of high
2 school graduate for purposes of postsecondary educational
3 financial aid; and to provide a duty for the Revisor of
4 Statutes.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. For purposes of financial aid relating to
2 postsecondary education and admission to postsecondary educational
3 institutions, a student shall be deemed a high school graduate
4 if he or she has obtained an associate of arts degree or an
5 associate of science degree from a community college in Nebraska
6 if the student earning such degree has completed, at an accredited
7 high school in Nebraska, a community college in Nebraska, or a
8 combination thereof, the following academic credits:

- 9 (1) Four units of English;
10 (2) Three units of mathematics;
11 (3) Three units of natural science; and
12 (4) Four units of social science.

13 Sec. 2. The Revisor of Statutes shall assign section 1 of
14 this act to Chapter 79, article 7.
