A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska County and City Lottery Act; to
 amend sections 9-601, 9-603, and 9-607, Reissue Revised

 Statutes of Nebraska; to define and redefine terms; to
 change restrictions on keno; to harmonize provisions; and
 to repeal the original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 9-601, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 9-601 Sections 9-601 to 9-653 and sections 3 and 4 of
- 4 this act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska County and
- 5 City Lottery Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. Section 9-603, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 7 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 8 9-603 For purposes of the Nebraska County and City
- 9 Lottery Act, the definitions found in sections 9-603.02 to 9-618
- 10 and sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be used.
- 11 Sec. 3. Activation, with regard to lottery equipment,
- 12 means initiating the selection of winning numbers.
- Sec. 4. <u>Ticket means a representation of a player's</u>
- 14 wager, which may be paper, electronic, or any other medium
- 15 approved by the department as a secure way to provide evidence
- 16 of participation in a lottery as long as it is capable of being
- 17 printed on paper.
- 18 Sec. 5. Section 9-607, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 19 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 20 9-607 (1) Lottery shall mean a gambling scheme in which:
- 21 (a) The players pay or agree to pay something of value
- 22 for an opportunity to win;
- 23 (b) Winning opportunities are represented by tickets;
- (c) Winners are solely determined by one of the following
- 25 two methods:

1 (i) By a random drawing of tickets differentiated by

- 2 sequential enumeration from a receptacle by hand whereby each
- 3 ticket has an equal chance of being chosen in the drawing; or
- 4 (ii) By use of a game known as keno in which a player
- 5 selects up to twenty numbers from a total of eighty numbers on a
- 6 paper ticket and a computer, other electronic selection device, or
- 7 electrically operated blower machine which is not player-activated
- 8 randomly selects up to twenty numbers from the same pool of
- 9 eighty numbers and the winning players are determined by the
- 10 correct matching of the numbers on the paper ticket selected by
- 11 the players with the numbers randomly selected by the computer,
- 12 other electronic selection device, or electrically operated blower
- 13 machine, except that no keno game shall permit or require player
- 14 access or activation of lottery equipment and the random selection
- 15 of numbers by the computer, other electronic selection device, or
- 16 electrically operated blower machine shall not occur within five
- 17 minutes of the completion of the previous selection of random
- 18 numbers; and
- 19 (d) The holders of the winning paper tickets are to
- 20 receive cash or prizes redeemable for cash. Selection of a winner
- 21 or winners shall be predicated solely on chance.
- 22 (2) Lottery shall not include:
- 23 (a) Any gambling scheme which uses any mechanical gaming
- 24 device, computer gaming device, electronic gaming device, or video
- 25 gaming device which has the capability of awarding something of

1 value, free games redeemable for something of value, or tickets or

- 2 stubs redeemable for something of value;
- 3 (b) Any activity authorized or regulated under the
- 4 Nebraska Bingo Act, the Nebraska Lottery and Raffle Act, the
- 5 Nebraska Pickle Card Lottery Act, the Nebraska Small Lottery and
- 6 Raffle Act, the State Lottery Act, section 9-701, or Chapter 2,
- 7 article 12; or
- 8 (c) Any activity prohibited under Chapter 28, article 11.
- 9 (3) Notwithstanding the requirement in subdivision
- 10 (1)(c)(ii) of this section that a player select up to twenty
- 11 numbers, a player may select more than twenty numbers on a paper
- 12 ticket when a top or bottom, left or right, edge, or way ticket
- 13 is played. For a top or bottom ticket, the player shall select
- 14 all numbers from one through forty or all numbers from forty-one
- 15 through eighty. For a left or right ticket, the player shall select
- 16 all numbers ending in one through five or all numbers ending in
- 17 six through zero. For an edge ticket, the player shall select all
- 18 of the numbers comprising the outside edge of the ticket. For a way
- 19 ticket, the player shall select a combination of groups of numbers
- 20 in multiple ways on a single ticket.
- 21 (4) A county, city, or village conducting a keno lottery
- 22 shall designate the method of winning number selection to be used
- 23 in the lottery and submit such designation in writing to the
- 24 department prior to conducting a keno lottery. Only those methods
- 25 of winning number selection described in subdivision (1)(c)(ii) of

1 this section shall be permitted, and the method of winning number

- 2 selection initially utilized may only be changed once during that
- 3 business day as set forth in the designation. A county, city, or
- 4 village shall not change the method or methods of winning number
- 5 selection filed with the department or allow it to be changed
- 6 once such initial designation has been made unless (a) otherwise
- 7 authorized in writing by the department based upon a written
- 8 request from the county, city, or village or (b) an emergency
- 9 arises in which case a ball draw method of number selection would
- 10 be switched to a number selection by a random number generator.
- 11 An emergency situation shall be reported by the county, city,
- 12 or village to the department within twenty-four hours of its
- 13 occurrence.
- 14 Sec. 6. Original sections 9-601, 9-603, and 9-607,
- 15 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
