A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to the Abstracters Act; to amend sections

 76-545, 76-547, and 76-550, Reissue Revised Statutes of

 Nebraska; to change provisions relating to certificate

 terms, fees, and rosters of abstracters; to provide an

 operative date; and to repeal the original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 76-545, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 76-545 Any individual or business entity desiring to
- 4 engage in the business of abstracting in this state shall make
- 5 application to the board for a certificate of authority. Such
- 6 application shall be in a form prepared by the board and shall
- 7 contain such information as may be necessary to assist the board in
- 8 determining whether the applicant has complied with the Abstracters
- 9 Act. Such application shall be accompanied by an application
- 10 fee of not less than twenty-five dollars or more than one
- 11 two hundred dollars. The board shall establish such fee based
- 12 on the administrative costs of the board. The applicant shall
- 13 furnish proof that such applicant is or has employed a registered
- 14 abstracter and shall provide the name and address of a resident
- 15 agent for service of process under the act. When this section
- 16 has been complied with, the board shall issue a certificate of
- 17 authority in such form as it may prescribe, attesting to the same,
- 18 and such certificate shall be prominently displayed in the place of
- 19 business of the applicant.
- 20 Sec. 2. Section 76-547, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 21 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 22 76-547 (1) All certificates of authority issued pursuant
- 23 to section 76-545 shall expire on April 1 of each even-numbered
- 24 year irrespective of when issued. Such certificates shall be
- 25 renewed, as provided in this section, for a one-year two-year

1 period upon payment of a renewal fee of not less than twenty-five

- 2 fifty dollars or more than two four hundred dollars. The board
- 3 shall establish such fee based on the administrative costs of the
- 4 board.
- 5 (2) All certificates of registration, including duplicate
- 6 certificates of registration, issued pursuant to section 76-543
- 7 shall expire on April 1 of each even-numbered year irrespective
- 8 of when issued. Such certificates shall be renewed, as provided
- 9 in this section, for a two-year period upon payment of a renewal
- 10 fee of not less than twenty fifty dollars or more than two
- 11 four hundred dollars. The board shall establish such fee based
- 12 on the administrative costs of the board. The board shall not
- 13 renew the certificate of registration or duplicate certificate
- 14 of registration for any registered abstracter who has failed to
- 15 complete the professional development requirements set forth in
- 16 section 76-544, unless the registered abstracter has shown good
- 17 cause why he or she was unable to comply with such requirements. If
- 18 the board determines that good cause was shown for not completing
- 19 the professional development requirements, the board shall permit
- 20 the registered abstracter to make up all outstanding hours of
- 21 professional development within six months of the renewal of such
- 22 certificates. If the hours are not completed in six months, such
- 23 certificates shall be revoked.
- 24 (3) Thirty to sixty days prior to the expiration date
- 25 of the certificates, the board shall cause a notice of expiration

1 and application for renewal, including a statement for the fee

- 2 for each certificate, to be mailed to each of the holders of
- 3 such certificates. The notice and application shall be in a form
- 4 prepared by the board.
- 5 Sec. 3. Section 76-550, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 6 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 7 76-550 The board shall keep a register of the name of
- 8 each applicant for certification, with his or her place of business
- 9 and such other information as may be deemed appropriate, including
- 10 a notation of the action taken by the board thereon, the date upon
- 11 which the certificate of registration or certificate of authority
- 12 is issued, and the date of renewal of such certificates. The
- 13 board shall maintain other records, registers, and files as may
- 14 be necessary for the proper administration of its duties pursuant
- 15 to the Abstracters Act. A roster showing the names and places
- 16 of business of abstracters holding an operative certificate of
- 17 registration shall be prepared by the director during the month
- 18 of June of every each even-numbered year, sent to all registered
- 19 abstracters, and furnished to the public on request at the cost of
- 20 producing such roster.
- 21 Sec. 4. This act becomes operative on January 1, 2012.
- 22 Sec. 5. Original sections 76-545, 76-547, and 76-550,
- 23 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
