- FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Rules of the Road; to amend section 60-6,131, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change requirements for driving in the right-hand lane of a roadway; and to repeal the original section.

- 3 60-6,131 (1) Upon all roadways of sufficient width, a
- 4 vehicle shall be driven upon the right half of the roadway except:
- 5 as follows:
- 6 (a) When overtaking and passing another vehicle
- 7 proceeding in the same direction under the rules governing such
- 8 movement;
- 9 (b) When an obstruction exists making it necessary to
- 10 drive to the left of the center of the highway, except that
- 11 any person so doing shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles
- 12 traveling in the proper direction upon the unobstructed portion
- 13 of the highway within such distance as to constitute an immediate
- 14 hazard;
- 15 (c) Upon a roadway divided into three marked lanes for
- 16 traffic under the which is subject to subsection (2) of this
- 17 section or other rules applicable thereon; or
- (d) Upon a roadway restricted to one-way traffic.

- 2 (2) Upon any roadway having two or more lanes for traffic
- 3 moving in the same direction, every vehicle shall be driven in the
- 4 right-hand lane then available for traffic except:
- 5 (a) When overtaking and passing another vehicle

- 7 (b) When traveling at a speed greater than the traffic
- 8 flow;
- 9 (c) When moving left to allow traffic to merge; or
- 10 (d) When preparing for a left turn at an intersection, at
- 11 an exit, or into a private road or driveway when the left turn is
- 12 <u>legally permitted.</u>
- 13 (3) Upon any roadway having four or more lanes for moving
- 14 traffic and providing for two-way movement of traffic, no vehicle
- 15 shall be driven to the left of the centerline of the roadway except
- 16 when authorized by official traffic control devices designating
- 17 certain lanes to the left side of the center of the roadway for use
- 18 by traffic not otherwise permitted to use such lanes or except as
- 19 permitted under subdivision (1)(b) of this section. This subsection
- 20 shall not be construed to prohibit the crossing of the centerline
- 21 in making a left turn into or from an alley, private road, or
- 22 driveway unless such movement is otherwise prohibited by signs.
