 emergency.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. The following sums of money, or so much

- 2 thereof as may be required, are hereby appropriated from the
- 3 General Fund or from other funds as indicated in the state
- 4 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for the payment of tort
- 5 claims which have been settled by the State Claims Board and
- 6 approved by the district court, which have been settled by the
- 7 Attorney General in the district court, or in which court judgments
- 8 have been entered and which require the approval of the Legislature
- 9 for payment.

- 11 02-593, 02-594, 02-596, against the Department of Health and Human

The Director of Administrative Services is hereby authorized and directed to draw his or her warrants upon the 4 funds in the state treasury enumerated in this act, in favor of 5 the several beneficiaries named in this act for the amount set 6 7 opposite their respective names upon the presentation of proper 8 vouchers therefor. The several amounts appropriated in this act shall be in full payment of any and all claims, rights, causes 9 10 of action, damages, and demands of every character and kind owing 11 by or against the State of Nebraska, its officers, agents, and 12 employees, and their successors and assigns with respect to each 13 of the beneficiaries respectively in whose favor the appropriations are made. The director shall not deliver any warrant for any 14 15 items appropriated in this act until a receipt and release in 16 full, releasing the State of Nebraska, its officers, employees, and 17 agents, and their successors and assigns, has been filed by each of the beneficiaries respectively. Upon presentation of the warrants, 18 19 the State Treasurer is hereby directed to pay the same out of money 20 in the General Fund or out of money in other funds indicated in 21 this act not otherwise appropriated. 22 Sec. 4.
