- 17 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on January 1, 2010.
- 18 Sec. 3. Original Laws 2009, LB 315, section 106, is
- 19 repealed.
- 20 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 21 when passed and approved according to law.
