3 There is included in the appropriation to this program
4 for FY2009-10 \$13,688 Cash Funds for regulatory support for
5 emergency medical technicians-intermediate and emergency medical
6 technicians-paramedic licensing from the Nebraska Health Care Cash
7 Fund. There is included in the appropriation to this program
8 for FY2010-11 \$13,688 Cash Funds for regulatory support for
9 emergency medical technicians-intermediate and emergency medical
10 technicians-paramedic licensing from the Nebraska Health Care Cash
11 Fund.

12 There is included in the appropriation to this program
13 for FY2009-10 \$26,000 Cash Funds from the Nebraska Health Care
14 Cash Fund to continue the Parkinson's Disease Registry. There is
15 included in the appropriation to this program for FY2010-11 \$26,000
16 Cash Funds from the Nebraska Health Care Cash Fund to continue the
17 Parkinson's Disease Registry.

18 There is included in the appropriation to this program
19 \$404,643 Cash Funds for FY2009-10 and \$404,643 Cash Funds for
20 FY2010-11 from the Nebraska Health Care Cash Fund for respite
21 services in each of the service areas designated by the Department
22 of Health and Human Services and for administrative costs,
23 including personnel costs, associated with the Nebraska Lifespan
24 Respite Services Program.

25 There is included in the appropriation to this program

1 for FY2009-10 \$25,000 Cash Funds from the Nebraska Health Care
2 Cash Fund for compulsive gamblers assistance programs. There is
3 included in the appropriation to this program for FY2010-11 \$25,000
4 Cash Funds from the Nebraska Health Care Cash Fund for compulsive
5 gamblers assistance programs.

6 There is included in the appropriation to this program
7 for FY2009-10 \$6,000 Cash Funds from the Nebraska Health Care Cash
8 Fund for costs relating to the implementation of smoking cessation
9 covered by medicaid. There is included in the appropriation to this
10 program for FY2010-11 \$6,000 Cash Funds from the Nebraska Health
11 Care Cash Fund for costs relating to the implementation of smoking
12 cessation covered by medicaid.

13 There is included in the appropriation to this program
14 for FY2009-10 \$150,000 General Funds to contract for a rate
15 methodology study for developmental disability services, which
16 shall only be used for such purpose.

17 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on January 1, 2010.

18 Sec. 3. Original Laws 2009, LB 315, section 106, is
19 repealed.

20 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
21 when passed and approved according to law.
