# LEGISLATIVE BILL 170

## A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to conservators; to amend section 30-2630.01,
- 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
- 3 provisions relating to appointment of a temporary
- 4 conservator; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 30-2630.01, Reissue Revised Statutes

- 2 of Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 30-2630.01 (a) If a person alleged to be in need
- 4 of protection under section 30-2630 has no conservator and an
- 5 emergency exists, the court may, pending notice and hearing,
- 6 exercise the power of a conservator or enter an emergency
- 7 protective order appointing a temporary conservator to address
- 8 the emergency.
- 9 (b) When the court takes action to exercise the powers
- 10 of a conservator or to appoint a temporary conservator under
- 11 subsection (a) of this section, an expedited hearing shall be held
- 12 if requested by the person alleged to be in need of protection,
- 13 or by any interested party, if the request is filed more than ten
- 14 business days prior to the date set for the hearing on the petition
- 15 for appointment of the conservator. If an expedited hearing is
- 16 to be held, the hearing shall be held within ten business days
- 17 after the request is received. At the hearing on the temporary
- 18 appointment, the petitioner shall have the burden of showing by
- 19 a preponderance of the evidence that temporary conservatorship
- 20 continues to be necessary to address the emergency situation.
- 21 Unless the person alleged to be in need of protection has counsel
- 22 of his or her own choice, the court may appoint an attorney to
- 23 represent the person at the hearing as provided in section 30-2636.
- 24 (c) If an expedited hearing is requested, notice shall
- 25 be served as provided in section 30-2634. The notice shall specify

1 that a temporary conservator has been appointed and shall be given

- 2 at least twenty-four hours prior to the expedited hearing.
- 3 (d) At the expedited hearing, the court may render a
- 4 judgment authorizing the temporary conservatorship to continue
- 5 beyond the original ten-day period. The judgment shall prescribe
- 6 the specific powers and duties of the temporary conservator in the
- 7 letters of temporary conservatorship and shall be effective for at
- 8 <u>least</u> a ninety-day period or for a longer period designated by
- 9 order of the court. For good cause shown, the court may extend the
- 10 temporary conservatorship for successive ninety-day periods.
- 11 (e) The temporary conservatorship shall terminate at
- 12 the end of the ninety-day period in during which the temporary
- 13 conservatorship is valid or at any time prior thereto if the
- 14 court deems the circumstances leading to the order for temporary
- 15 conservatorship no longer exist or if an order has been entered as
- 16 a result of a hearing pursuant to section 30-2636 which has been
- 17 held during the ninety-day or longer court-ordered period.
- 18 (f) If the court denies the request for the ex parte
- 19 order, the court may, in its discretion, enter an order for an
- 20 expedited hearing pursuant to subsections (b) through (e) of this
- 21 section.
- 22 (g) If the petitioner requests the entry of an order
- 23 of temporary conservatorship pursuant to subsection (a) of this
- 24 section without requesting an ex parte order, the court may hold an
- 25 expedited hearing pursuant to subsections (b) through (e) of this

- 1 section.
- 2 (h) A temporary conservator may be removed at any time.
- 3 A temporary conservator shall make any report the court requires.
- 4 In other respects the provisions of the Nebraska Probate Code
- 5 concerning conservators apply to temporary conservators.
