2			60-4,123, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2008;
3			to restrict the issuance of such permits as prescribed;
4			and to repeal the original section.

Section 1. Section 60-4,123, Revised Statutes Cumulative
 Supplement, 2008, is amended to read:

3 60-4,123 (1) Any person who is at least fifteen years of age may apply for an LPD-learner's permit from the department. 4 5 In order to obtain an LPD-learner's permit, the applicant shall 6 successfully complete a written examination. A person may take 7 the written examination beginning sixty days prior to his or her 8 fifteenth birthday but shall not be issued a permit until he 9 or she is fifteen years of age. The written examination may be 10 waived for any person who has been issued an LPE-learner's permit, 11 LPD-learner's permit, or SCP-school permit that has been expired 12 for no more than one year.

13 (2) Upon successful completion of the written examination
14 and the payment of a fee and surcharge as prescribed in section
15 60-4,115, the applicant shall be issued an LPD-learner's permit as
16 provided in section 60-4,113. The permit shall be valid for twelve
17 months.

18 (3) (a) The holder of an LPD-learner's permit shall only operate a motor vehicle on the highways of this state if he or 19 20 she is accompanied at all times by a licensed operator who is at 21 least twenty-one years of age and who has been licensed by this 22 state or another state and if he or she is actually occupying the 23 seat beside the licensed operator or, in the case of a motorcycle 24 or moped, if he or she is within visual contact of and under the 25 supervision of, in the case of a motorcycle, a licensed motorcycle

1 operator or, in the case of a moped, a licensed motor vehicle
2 operator.

3 (b) The holder of an LPD-learner's permit shall not 4 use any type of interactive wireless communication device while 5 operating a motor vehicle on the highways of this state. 6 Enforcement of this subdivision shall be accomplished only as a 7 secondary action when the holder of the LPD-learner's permit has 8 been cited or charged with a violation of some other law.

9 (4) The county treasurer shall collect the fee and 10 surcharge prescribed in section 60-4,115 for the issuance of each 11 LPD-learner's permit.

12 (5) A person over eighteen years of age shall be issued
 13 an LPD-learner's permit only one time. The director may waive this
 14 restriction for good cause shown.
