1	FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska State Fair; to amend sections
2	2-109, 2-110, 2-111, and 2-1208.01, Reissue Revised
3	Statutes of Nebraska, and section 2-103, Revised Statutes
4	Cumulative Supplement, 2008; to change and eliminate
5	provisions relating to board membership, relocation,
6	reports, studies, and horseracing; to create a fund; to
7	provide operative dates; to repeal the original sections;
8	and to outright repeal section 2-131, Reissue Revised
9	Statutes of Nebraska.
10	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 2-103, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2008, is amended to read:
- 3 2-103 (1) The Nebraska State Fair Board shall be a board
- 4 consisting of the following members:
- 5 (a) Seven members nominated and selected by district as
- 6 provided in the constitution and bylaws of the board; and
- 7 (b) Four members appointed by the Governor and confirmed
- 8 by the Legislature, three members selected from the business
- 9 community of the state with one such member residing in each of the
- 10 three congressional districts, as such districts existed on January
- 11 1, 2009, and one member selected from the business community of the
- 12 most populous city within the county in which the Nebraska State
- 13 Fair is located.
- 14 (2) The term of office for members of the board shall
- 15 be for three years. Members selected by gubernatorial appointment
- 16 pursuant to subdivision (1)(b) of this section as it existed
- 17 prior to January 1, 2009, who continue to be qualified to serve
- 18 shall continue their term of appointment and shall be eligible for
- 19 reappointment subject to the limit of terms served prescribed in
- 20 subsection (3) of this section. In the event that the Nebraska
- 21 State Fair is to be relocated to a new host community, the term of
- 22 the member appointed or designated from the business community of
- 23 the previous host community shall be vacated on the first day of
- 24 the calendar year in which the Nebraska State Fair is relocated.
- 25 The and the Governor shall appoint a new member from the business

1 community of the most populous city within the county in which the

- 2 Nebraska State Fair is located relocated to fulfill the remainder
- 3 of the term of the vacating member.
- 4 (3) No person may serve more than three consecutive terms
- 5 as a member of the board. No member of the Legislature may serve on
- 6 the board.
- 7 (4) The board shall annually elect from its membership
- 8 a chairperson, a vice-chairperson, a secretary, and such other
- 9 officers as the board deems necessary. The officers shall be
- 10 elected at the annual meeting of the board, or any other meeting of
- 11 the board called for such purpose, and shall hold their offices for
- 12 one year and until their successors are elected and qualified.
- 13 (5) The State 4-H Program Administrator of the
- 14 Cooperative Extension Service of the University of Nebraska, or his
- 15 or her designee, and the Executive Director of the Nebraska FFA, or
- 16 his or her designee, shall be ex officio, nonvoting members of the
- 17 Nebraska State Fair Board.
- 18 Sec. 2. Section 2-109, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 19 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 20 2-109 The Department of Revenue shall, on a quarterly
- 21 basis, at the conclusion of each calendar quarter, provide to the
- 22 most populous city within the county in which the state fair is
- 23 located, held written notification of the amount estimated by the
- 24 department to equal ten percent of the lottery revenue collected
- 25 during the calendar quarter to be transferred to the Nebraska

1 State Fair Support and Improvement Cash Fund. <u>If the state fair is</u>

- 2 scheduled to be held in a different county from that in which the
- 3 most recent state fair was held, the written notification required
- 4 by this section shall be made to the most populous city within the
- 5 county in which the state fair is scheduled to be held beginning
- 6 with the written notification made at the conclusion of the first
- 7 calendar quarter during the calendar year in which the state fair
- 8 is held or scheduled to be held in such county. The department
- 9 shall provide a copy of the written notification to the Department
- 10 of Administrative Services.
- 11 Sec. 3. Section 2-110, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 12 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 13 2-110 The most populous city within the county in
- 14 which the state fair is located Nebraska State Fair is held
- 15 or scheduled to be held that calendar year shall remit quarterly
- 16 payments to the State Treasurer in amounts equal to the matching
- 17 fund requirement established by the Department of Revenue under
- 18 section 2-109. The State Treasurer shall credit the matching funds
- 19 to the Nebraska State Fair Support and Improvement Cash Fund.
- 20 The city shall provide written notification to the Department
- 21 of Administrative Services regarding its compliance with the
- 22 matching fund requirement. Upon verification by the Department
- 23 of Administrative Services that a quarterly transfer of lottery
- 24 proceeds to the Nebraska State Fair Support and Improvement Cash
- 25 Fund has been executed and that the full amount of the matching

1 funds requirement has been received from the city, the Department

- 2 of Administrative Services shall authorize the expenditure of the
- 3 fund by the Nebraska State Fair Board. Matching fund requirements
- 4 shall not apply to investment income accruing to the fund and
- 5 investment income may be expended by the board.
- 6 Sec. 4. Section 2-111, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 7 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 8 2-111 (1) The Nebraska State Fair Board shall, no later
- 9 than November 1 of each year, provide an annual report to the
- 10 Governor and the Legislature regarding the use of the Nebraska
- 11 State Fair Support and Improvement Cash Fund. The report shall
- 12 include (a) (1) a detailed listing of how the proceeds of the
- 13 fund were expended in the prior fiscal year and (b) (2) any
- 14 distributions from the fund that remain unexpended and on deposit
- 15 in Nebraska State Fair accounts.
- 16 (2) The Nebraska State Fair Board shall cooperate with a
- 17 study by the Agriculture Committee of the Legislature of capital
- 18 facilities and infrastructure requirements to serve the purposes
- 19 and goals of the Nebraska State Fair and other uses of the Nebraska
- 20 State Fairgrounds as a year-round multipurpose facility sufficient
- 21 to host and accommodate events and attractions of local, state, and
- 22 regional interest and attendance. The Nebraska State Fair Board may
- 23 utilize available funds, not to exceed one hundred fifty thousand
- 24 dollars, including funds disbursed from the Nebraska State Fair
- 25 Support and Improvement Cash Fund and other resources, to assist in

1 completion of such study. This subsection terminates on January 1,

- 2 2008.
- 3 Sec. 5. (1) The State Fair Host Facility Maintenance
- 4 Assistance Fund is created. The State Treasurer shall credit to
- 5 the fund the amounts remitted to the fund pursuant to section
- 6 2-1208.01 and any funds appropriated by the Legislature or any
- 7 other funds received as gifts, grants, or other contributions to
- 8 such fund received from any source, public or private, for purposes
- 9 of the fund. The fund shall be expended by the Department of
- 10 Economic Development as grants in aid to a facility serving as
- 11 the host facility of the Nebraska State Fair for the maintenance
- 12 of buildings, streets, utilities, and other improvements upon
- 13 the premises of such facility. The money in the fund shall not
- 14 be subject to any fiscal year or biennium limitation requiring
- 15 reappropriation of the unexpended balance at the end of the fiscal
- 16 year or biennium. Any money in the fund available for investment
- 17 shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant to
- 18 the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds
- 19 Investment Act.
- 20 (2) A facility that is the recipient of funds distributed
- 21 pursuant to subsection (1) of this section shall, no later than
- 22 November 1 of each year, provide a report to the Governor and the
- 23 Legislature regarding the use of the funds received from the fund
- 24 that includes a detailed listing of how the funds were expended in
- 25 the prior fiscal year.

1 Sec. 6. Section 2-1208.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 2-1208.01 (1) There is hereby imposed a tax on the gross
- 4 sum wagered by the parimutuel method at each race enclosure during
- 5 a calendar year as follows:
- 6 (1) For meets conducted on the Nebraska State
- 7 Fairgrounds, no tax shall be imposed, but the licensee shall apply
- 8 two percent of any amount in excess of ten million dollars for the
- 9 purpose of maintenance of buildings, streets, utilities, and other
- 10 existing improvements on the Nebraska State Fairgrounds; and
- 11 (2) For all other meets:
- 12 (a) The first ten million dollars shall not be taxed;
- 13 (b) Any amount over ten million dollars but less than or
- 14 equal to seventy-three million dollars shall be taxed at the rate
- 15 of two and one-half percent; and
- 16 (c) Any amount in excess of seventy-three million dollars
- 17 shall be taxed at the rate of four percent. + and
- 18 (d) (2) An amount equal to two percent of the first
- 19 taxable seventy million dollars at each race meeting shall
- 20 be retained by the licensee for capital improvements and for
- 21 maintenance of the premises within the licensed racetrack enclosure
- 22 and shall be a credit against the tax levied in subsection (1) of
- 23 this section.
- 24 (3) A return as required by the Tax Commissioner shall be
- 25 filed for a racetrack enclosure for each month during which wagers

1 are accepted at the enclosure. The return shall be filed with and

- 2 the net tax due pursuant to this section shall be paid to the
- 3 Department of Revenue on the tenth day of the following month.
- 4 (4) On or before July 1, 2010, and on or before July 1
- 5 of each year thereafter, the State Treasurer shall remit thirty
- 6 thousand dollars of the tax collected pursuant to this section to
- 7 the State Fair Host Facility Maintenance Assistance Fund.
- 8 Sec. 7. Sections 6 and 9 of this act become operative on
- 9 January 1, 2010. The other sections of this act become operative on
- 10 their effective date.
- 11 Sec. 8. Original sections 2-109, 2-110, and 2-111,
- 12 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 2-103, Revised
- 13 Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2008, are repealed.
- 14 Sec. 9. Original section 2-1208.01, Reissue Revised
- 15 Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
- 16 Sec. 10. The following section is outright repealed:
