### A BILL

1	FOR AN ACT relating to gambling; to amend sections $9-255.04$ , $9-347$ ,
2	and 9-347.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
3	change provisions relating to the definite profit of
4	pickle cards; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the
5	original sections.

6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 9-255.04, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 9-255.04 (1) No expense shall be incurred or amounts paid
4 in connection with the conduct of bingo by a licensed organization
5 except those which are reasonable and necessary.

6 (2) A licensed organization shall not spend more than 7 fourteen percent of its bingo gross receipts to pay the expenses of 8 conducting bingo. The actual cost of (a) license and local permit 9 fees, (b) any taxes authorized by the Nebraska Bingo Act, (c) 10 bingo and promotional prizes, (d) the purchase, rental, or lease 11 of bingo equipment, and (e) the rental or lease of a premises for 12 the conduct of bingo and the purchase, rental, or lease of personal 13 property as allowed by the department in rule and regulation which 14 is necessary for the conduct of bingo shall not be included in 15 determining compliance with the expense limitation contained in 16 this section.

(3) A licensed organization which is also licensed to 17 conduct a lottery by the sale of pickle cards pursuant to the 18 Nebraska Pickle Card Lottery Act may allocate a portion of the 19 20 expenses associated with the conduct of its bingo occasions to 21 its lottery by the sale of pickle cards conducted at such bingo 22 occasions. Such allocation shall be based upon the percentage that pickle card gross proceeds derived from the sale of pickle cards 23 24 at the bingo occasions represents to the total of bingo gross 25 receipts and pickle card gross proceeds derived from such bingo

1 occasions for the previous annual reporting period. An organization 2 licensed to conduct bingo that has not been previously licensed 3 shall determine such allocation based upon the percentage that 4 pickle card gross proceeds derived from the sale of pickle cards at 5 the bingo occasions represents to the total of bingo gross receipts 6 and pickle card gross proceeds derived from such bingo occasions 7 for the initial three consecutive calendar months of operation.

8 (4) The total amount of expenses that may be allocated 9 to the organization's lottery by the sale of pickle cards shall be 10 subject to the limitations on bingo expenses as provided for in 11 the Nebraska Bingo Act with respect to the fourteen-percent expense 12 limitation and the fair-market-value limitation on the purchase, 13 rental, or lease of bingo equipment and the rental or lease of 14 personal property or of a premises for the conduct of bingo. No 15 portion of the eight ten percent of the definite profit of a pickle 16 card unit as allowed by section 9-347 to pay the allowable expenses of operating a lottery by the sale of pickle cards shall be used 17 18 to pay any expenses associated with the sale of pickle cards at a 19 bingo occasion.

(5) All persons paid for working at a bingo occasion, including pickle card sellers but excluding concession workers, shall be paid only by a check written from the licensed organization's bingo checking account and shall not receive any other compensation or payment for working at a bingo occasion from any other source. Such wages shall be at an hourly or

occasion rate and shall be included in the amount allowed by the expense limitation provided in subsection (2) of this section. No person shall receive any compensation or payment from a licensed organization based upon a percentage of the organization's bingo gross receipts or profit.

6 (6) No expenses associated with the conduct of bingo 7 may be paid directly from the licensed organization's pickle card 8 checking account. A licensed organization may transfer funds from 9 its pickle card checking account to its bingo checking account as 10 permitted by subsection (3) of this section by a check drawn on 11 the pickle card checking account or by electronic funds transfer as 12 provided only by section 9-347.

Sec. 2. Section 9-347, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is amended to read:

9-347 (1) The gross proceeds of any lottery by the sale of pickle cards shall be used solely for lawful purposes, awarding of prizes, payment of the unit cost, any commission paid to a pickle card operator, allowable expenses, and allocations for bingo expenses as provided by subsection (5) of this section.

20 (2) Not less than sixty-five percent or more than eighty
21 percent of the gross proceeds of any lottery by the sale of pickle
22 cards shall be used for the awarding of prizes.

(3) Not more than eight ten percent of the definite
profit of a pickle card unit shall be used by the licensed
organization to pay the allowable expenses of operating a lottery

by the sale of pickle cards, except that license fees paid to the 1 2 department to license the organization, each utilization-of-funds 3 member, and any sales agent and pickle card dispensing device registration fees shall not be included in determining the 4 eight-percent ten-percent limitation on expenses and no portion 5 6 of such eight ten percent shall be used to pay any expenses 7 associated with the sale of pickle cards at a bingo occasion 8 conducted pursuant to the Nebraska Bingo Act, and of such eight 9 ten percent not more than four percent of the definite profit 10 may be used by the licensed organization for the payment of any 11 commission, salary, or fee to a sales agent in connection with 12 the marketing, sale, and delivery of a pickle card unit. When 13 determining the eight ten percent of definite profit that is 14 permitted to pay the allowable expenses of operating a lottery by 15 the sale of pickle cards, the definite profit from the sale of 16 pickle cards at the organization's bingo occasions shall not be 17 included.

18 (4) Not more than thirty percent of the definite profit 19 of a pickle card unit shall be used by a licensed organization 20 to pay a pickle card operator a commission, fee, or salary for 21 selling individual pickle cards as opportunities for participation 22 in a lottery by the sale of pickle cards on behalf of the licensed 23 organization.

(5) An organization licensed to conduct bingo pursuant
to the Nebraska Bingo Act may allocate a portion of the expenses

associated with the conduct of its bingo occasions to its lottery 1 2 by the sale of pickle cards conducted at such bingo occasions. 3 Such allocation shall be based upon the percentage that pickle card gross proceeds derived from the sale of pickle cards at the 4 5 bingo occasions represents to the total of bingo gross receipts 6 and pickle card gross proceeds derived from such bingo occasions 7 for the previous annual reporting period. An organization licensed 8 to conduct bingo that has not been previously licensed shall 9 determine such allocation based upon the percentage that pickle 10 card gross proceeds derived from the sale of pickle cards at the 11 bingo occasions represents to the total of bingo gross receipts 12 and pickle card gross proceeds derived from such bingo occasions 13 for the initial three consecutive calendar months of operation. 14 The total amount of expenses that may be allocated to the 15 organization's lottery by the sale of pickle cards shall be 16 subject to the limitations on bingo expenses as provided for in 17 the Nebraska Bingo Act with respect to the fourteen-percent expense 18 limitation and the fair-market-value limitation on the purchase, rental, or lease of bingo equipment and the rental or lease of 19 20 personal property or of a premises for the conduct of bingo. No 21 expenses associated with the conduct of bingo may be paid directly 22 from the pickle card checking account. A licensed organization which needs to allocate a portion of the expenses associated with 23 24 the conduct of its bingo occasions to its lottery by the sale 25 of pickle cards conducted at such bingo occasions to pay bingo

expenses as provided by this section shall transfer funds from the pickle card checking account to the bingo checking account by a check drawn on the pickle card checking account or by electronic funds transfer.

5 Sec. 3. Section 9-347.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of
6 Nebraska, is amended to read:

7 9-347.01 (1) For each type of pickle card unit marketed 8 in this state, the department shall determine the following: (a) 9 When a licensed organization sells pickle cards through pickle card 10 operators, the portion of the definite profit from that pickle card unit which shall go to the licensed organization, such amount to 11 12 be not less than seventy percent of the definite profit from such 13 pickle card unit; (b) the maximum amount of the definite profit 14 from the sale of a pickle card unit that a licensed organization 15 may pay a pickle card operator as a commission, fee, or salary to 16 sell its pickle cards, such amount not to exceed thirty percent of 17 the definite profit from such pickle card unit; (c) the portion 18 of the definite profit from the sale of a pickle card unit which may be expended by a licensed organization for allowable expenses, 19 20 such amount not to exceed eight ten percent of the definite profit 21 from such pickle card unit; and (d) the portion of the definite 22 profit from the sale of a pickle card unit which may be utilized by a licensed organization for payment of the organization's sales 23 24 agent, such amount to be a portion of the allowable expenses and 25 not to exceed four percent of the definite profit from such pickle

1 card unit.

2 (2) The licensed organization's net profit from the sale 3 of a pickle card unit shall be used exclusively for a lawful purpose. A licensed organization shall not donate or promise to 4 donate its net profit or any portion of the net profit to a 5 6 recipient outside of its organization as an inducement for or 7 in exchange for (a) a payment, gift, or other thing of value 8 from the recipient to any person, organization, or corporation, 9 including, but not limited to, the licensed organization or any 10 of its members, employees, or agents, or (b) a pickle card 11 operator's agreement to sell pickle cards on behalf of the licensed 12 organization.

Sec. 4. Original sections 9-255.04, 9-347, and 9-347.01,
Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
