Section 49-1446.02, Revised Section 1. Statutes 2 Cumulative Supplement, 2008, is amended to read:

3 49-1446.02 Notwithstanding any other provision of the Nebraska Political Accountability and Disclosure Act, no committee 4 5 shall expend funds for the purchase or payment of:

6 (1) Clothes or medical or dental expenses of a candidate 7 or the members of his or her immediate family;

8 (2) Installment payments for an automobile owned by a 9 candidate;

10 (3) Mortgage or rental payments for a permanent residence 11 of a candidate;

12 (4) The satisfaction of personal debts, including installment payments on personal loans, except campaign loans 13 subject to reporting required by subsection (2) of section 49-1456; 14 15 (5) Personal services, including the services of a 16 lawyer or accountant, except campaign services subject to reporting pursuant to the provisions of section 49-1455; or 17

18 (6) Office supplies, staff, or furnishings for the public 19 office for which an individual is a candidate for nomination or 20 election except as set out in subsection (2) of section 49-1446.01; 21 or.

22 (7) Postage or transportation services for an individual 23 voter or prospective voter for the purpose of requesting or 24 returning a ballot or transportation services to or from a polling 25 <u>site.</u>
