## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 366**

A BILL

1	FOR AN ACT relating to the State Employees Retirement Act; to amend
2	section 84-1308, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
3	increase the mandatory contribution rate; to provide an
4	operative date; to repeal the original section; and to
5	declare an emergency.

6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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Section 1. Section 84-1308, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 84-1308 (1) Each Beginning July 1, 2009, each employee who is a member of the retirement system shall pay or have paid 4 5 on his or her behalf a sum equal to four and eight-tenths five percent of his or her monthly compensation. Such amounts shall 6 7 be deducted monthly pursuant to subsection (2) of this section by 8 the Director of Administrative Services. All money received shall 9 be set aside by the State Treasurer and credited to the State 10 Employees Retirement Fund.

11 (2) The employer shall pick up the employee contributions 12 required by this section for all compensation paid on or after 13 January 1, 1985, and the contributions so picked up shall 14 be treated as employer contributions in determining federal tax 15 treatment under the Internal Revenue Code as defined in section 16 49-801.01, except that the employer shall continue to withhold federal income taxes based upon these contributions until the 17 18 Internal Revenue Service or the federal courts rule that, pursuant 19 to section 414(h) of the code, these contributions shall not be 20 included as gross income of the employee until such time as they 21 are distributed or made available. The employer shall pay these 22 employee contributions from the same source of funds which is 23 used in paying earnings to the employee. The employer shall pick 24 up these contributions by a deduction through a reduction in the 25 cash compensation of the employee. Employee contributions picked up

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LB 366 LB 366 1 shall be treated for all purposes of the State Employees Retirement 2 Act in the same manner and to the extent as employee contributions 3 made prior to the date picked up. 4 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2009. 5 Sec. 3. Original section 84-1308, Reissue Revised 6 Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed. Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect 7 8 when passed and approved according to law.
