FOR AN ACT relating to tobacco sales; to prohibit sale from a self-service display; to define terms; to create a penalty; and to provide an operative date. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, it is unlawful to sell cigarettes or other tobacco products from a self-service display. Any person violating this section is guilty of a Class III misdemeanor. In addition, upon conviction for a second offense, the court shall order a six-month suspension of the offender's license to sell tobacco, if any, and upon conviction for a third or subsequent offense, the court shall order the permanent revocation of the offender's license to sell tobacco, if any.
(2) Cigarettes or other tobacco products may be sold from a self-service display when such display is:
(a) Located in a tobacco specialty store; or
(b) A vending machine permitted under section 28-1429.02.
(3) For purposes of this section:
(a) Self-service display means a display that contains cigarettes or other tobacco products and is located in an area openly accessible to consumers at retail, from which such consumers can readily access cigarettes or other tobacco products without the assistance of the owner or operator of the retail establishment or an agent or employee of such owner or operator. Self-service display does not include a display case that holds cigarettes or other tobacco products behind locked doors; and
(b) Tobacco specialty store means a retail establishment that derives at least seventy-five percent of its revenue from the sale of cigarettes and other tobacco products.
