1 Section 1. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of

- 2 this section, it is unlawful to sell cigarettes or other tobacco
- 3 products from a self-service display. Any person violating this
- 4 section is guilty of a Class III misdemeanor. In addition, upon
- 5 conviction for a second offense, the court shall order a six-month
- 6 suspension of the offender's license to sell tobacco, if any, and
- 7 upon conviction for a third or subsequent offense, the court shall
- 8 order the permanent revocation of the offender's license to sell
- 9 tobacco, if any.
- 10 (2) Cigarettes or other tobacco products may be sold from
- 11 a self-service display when such display is:
- 12 (a) Located in a tobacco specialty store; or
- 13 (b) A vending machine permitted under section 28-1429.02.
- 14 (3) For purposes of this section:
- 15 (a) Self-service display means a display that contains
- 16 cigarettes or other tobacco products and is located in an area
- openly accessible to consumers at retail, from which such consumers
- 18 can readily access cigarettes or other tobacco products without the
- 19 assistance of the owner or operator of the retail establishment
- 20 or an agent or employee of such owner or operator. Self-service
- 21 display does not include a display case that holds cigarettes or
- 22 other tobacco products behind locked doors; and
- 23 (b) Tobacco specialty store means a retail establishment
- 24 that derives at least seventy-five percent of its revenue from the
- 25 sale of cigarettes and other tobacco products.
