A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Game Law; to amend section 37-407,
2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
3 provisions relating to nonresident permits; and to repeal
4 the original section.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 37-407, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 37-407 The commission may offer multiple-year permits or
4 combinations of permits at reduced rates and may establish fees
5 pursuant to section 37-327 to be paid to the state for resident
6 and nonresident ~~hunting permits~~, annual fishing permits, three-day
7 fishing permits, and one-day fishing permits, combination hunting
8 and fishing permits, resident and nonresident fur-harvesting
9 permits, resident hunting permits, and nonresident ~~special two-day~~
10 ten-day hunting permits issued for periods of ~~two ten~~ consecutive
11 days, between the Wednesday immediately preceding Thanksgiving Day
12 and December 31 of the same calendar year and limited to one
13 special two-day permit per applicant per year, as follows:

14 (1) Resident fees shall be (a) not more than thirteen
15 dollars for a hunting permit, (b) not more than seventeen dollars
16 and fifty cents for an annual fishing permit, (c) not more than
17 eleven dollars and fifty cents for a three-day fishing permit,
18 (d) not more than eight dollars for a one-day fishing permit, (e)
19 not more than twenty-nine dollars for ~~both fishing and hunting~~,
20 a combination hunting and fishing permit, and (f) not more than
21 twenty dollars for a fur harvesting permit; and

22 (2) Nonresident fees shall be (a) not more than two
23 hundred sixty dollars for a fur-harvesting permit for a period of
24 time specified by the commission for fur harvesting one thousand or
25 less fur-bearing animals and not more than seventeen dollars and

1 fifty cents additional for each one hundred or part of one hundred
2 fur-bearing animals harvested, (b) (i) for persons sixteen years of
3 age and older, not more than eighty dollars for ~~hunting a ten-day~~
4 hunting permit, plus the cost of a habitat stamp, and (ii) for
5 persons under sixteen years of age, not less than the fee required
6 pursuant to subdivision (1) (a) of this section for ~~hunting,~~ ~~(e) not~~
7 ~~more than thirty-five dollars for a special two-day hunting permit~~
8 a ten-day hunting permit, plus the cost of a habitat stamp, ~~(d)~~
9 (c) not more than nine dollars for a one-day fishing permit, ~~(e)~~
10 (d) not more than sixteen dollars and fifty cents for a three-day
11 fishing permit, and ~~(f)~~ (e) not more than forty-nine dollars and
12 fifty cents for an annual fishing permit.
