A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to state-owned motor vehicles; to amend section
2 81-1025, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to require
3 the installation and use of automatic vehicle location
4 system devices in such vehicles; and to repeal the
5 original section.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 81-1025, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 81-1025 (1) Each operator of a state-owned motor vehicle,
4 except a special-use vehicle as prescribed in section 81-1011 or a
5 motor vehicle in which a state agency holds the title, shall report
6 the points between which the motor vehicle traveled each time used,
7 the odometer readings at such points, the time of arrival and
8 departure, the necessity and purpose for such travel, the license
9 number of such motor vehicle, and the department to which such
10 motor vehicle belongs. Beginning January 1, 2011, each state-owned
11 motor vehicle shall have installed in it an automatic vehicle
12 location system device which shall record and account for each item
13 required to be reported under this subsection.

14 (2) (a) Each operator of a special-use vehicle as
15 prescribed in section 81-1011 or a motor vehicle in which a
16 state agency holds the title shall follow the policy and use the
17 travel report form which shall be established by the director or
18 designated head of the state agency owning such vehicle. The form
19 shall include, but not be limited to, the name of the operator, the
20 license number of the vehicle, the total daily mileage or total
21 hours of daily operation, and any other information the director
22 or designated head deems relevant.

23 (b) State agencies leasing or renting motor vehicles
24 from the transportation services bureau pursuant to sections
25 81-1008.01 and 81-1010 shall be required to report motor vehicle

1 usage pursuant to subsection (1) of this section on travel forms
2 prescribed by the chief of the transportation services bureau.

3 (3) Such travel reports shall be transmitted at the end
4 of each month by every operator to the director or designated head
5 of the operator's state agency, and such reports, after review by
6 the director or designated head of the agency, shall be retained by
7 the agency except the travel reports on motor vehicles leased or
8 rented from the transportation services bureau. The travel reports
9 on motor vehicles leased or rented from the transportation services
10 bureau shall be transmitted to the chief of such bureau on or
11 before the seventh day of the month following such use of a motor
12 vehicle.

13 (4) Such travel reports shall thereafter be open to
14 public inspection for a period of two years, after which they
15 may be destroyed, except that when public inspection of a
16 particular record would be detrimental to the investigation of
17 a criminal case, such particular record shall be withheld from
18 public inspection upon written certificate to that effect by the
19 head of the law enforcement agency concerned. Beginning January 1,
20 2011, all records created in the use of state-owned motor vehicles
21 equipped with automatic vehicle location system devices shall be
22 maintained on a public web site administered by the Department of
23 Administrative Services.

24 (5) For purposes of this section, state agency shall
25 include an agency, department, board, bureau, or commission of the

1 state except the transportation services bureau.

2 (6) For purposes of this section, automatic vehicle
3 location system device shall mean any global positioning satellite
4 receiver capable of being installed in a state-owned vehicle
5 that allows for a communications link between the receiver and a
6 computer-operated tracking system.
