A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to the medical assistance program; to amend section 68-912, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2008; to exempt certain adult dental services from limitations as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 68-912, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2008, is amended to read:
- 3 68-912 (1) The department may establish (a) premiums,
- 4 copayments, and deductibles for goods and services provided
- 5 under the medical assistance program, (b) except as provided in
- 6 subsection (5) of this section, limits on the amount, duration,
- 7 and scope of goods and services that recipients may receive
- 8 under the medical assistance program, and (c) requirements for
- 9 recipients of medical assistance as a necessary condition for the
- 10 continued receipt of such assistance, including, but not limited
- 11 to, active participation in care coordination and appropriate
- 12 disease management programs and activities.
- 13 (2) In establishing and limiting coverage for services
- 14 under the medical assistance program, the department shall consider
- 15 (a) the effect of such coverage and limitations on recipients
- 16 of medical assistance and medical assistance expenditures, (b)
- 17 the public policy in section 68-905, (c) the experience and
- 18 outcomes of other states, (d) the nature and scope of benchmark or
- 19 benchmark-equivalent health insurance coverage as recognized under
- 20 federal law, and (e) other relevant factors as determined by the
- 21 department.
- 22 (3) Coverage for mandatory and optional services and
- 23 limitations on covered services as established by the department
- 24 prior to July 1, 2006, shall remain in effect until revised,
- 25 amended, repealed, or nullified pursuant to law. Any proposed

1 reduction or expansion of services or limitation of covered

- 2 services by the department under this section shall be subject
- 3 to the reporting and review requirements of section 68-909.
- 4 (4) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection,
- 5 proposed rules and regulations under this section relating to the
- 6 establishment of premiums, copayments, or deductibles for eligible
- 7 recipients or limits on the amount, duration, or scope of covered
- 8 services for eligible recipients shall not become effective until
- 9 the conclusion of the earliest regular session of the Legislature
- 10 in which there has been a reasonable opportunity for legislative
- 11 consideration of such rules and regulations. This subsection does
- 12 not apply to rules and regulations that are (a) required by
- 13 federal or state law, (b) related to a waiver in which recipient
- 14 participation is voluntary, or (c) proposed due to a loss of
- 15 federal matching funds relating to a particular covered service
- 16 or eligibility category. Legislative consideration includes, but
- 17 is not limited to, the introduction of a legislative bill, a
- 18 legislative resolution, or an amendment to pending legislation
- 19 relating to such rules and regulations.
- 20 (5) The department shall exempt dental services provided
- 21 to adult recipients from limits on the amount, duration, and scope
- 22 of goods and services under the medical assistance program if the
- 23 recipient (a) is pregnant, (b) has a dental condition which if
- 24 untreated would (i) worsen an existing disease or medical condition
- 25 or (ii) cause increased costs for treatment of an existing disease

1 or medical condition, (c) has a dental condition which requires

- 2 a specific sequence of treatment that cannot be provided over a
- 3 length of time without violating basic dental standards of care,
- 4 (d) experienced trauma to the mouth or teeth and without immediate
- 5 dental treatment would suffer loss of front permanent teeth, or
- 6 (e) is a first-time eligible recipient under the medical assistance
- 7 program in Nebraska.
