- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to labor and employment; to prohibit certain
- 2 employers from requiring use of paid leave under certain
- 3 circumstances; and to provide a penalty.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

LB 554

1 Section 1. (1) Any employer with more than fifty

- 2 employees who provides for paid leave and has policies governing
- 3 unpaid leave shall not require an employee to use paid leave of
- 4 any kind when such employee has legitimately qualified, by law
- 5 or rule or regulation, for unpaid leave, unless such employee
- 6 requests to substitute paid leave at the time such employee submits
- 7 notification to the employer of the leave.
- 8 (2) Any employer who violates this section shall be
- 9 subject to a civil penalty of not less than five hundred dollars
- 10 for each offense. All civil penalties collected under this section
- 11 shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for distribution in
- 12 accordance with Article VII, section 5, of the Constitution of
- 13 Nebraska.
