A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to agriculture; to amend sections 2-2315,

 2-3631, and 2-4016, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska;

 to provide for expense reimbursement for first purchasers

 of certain commodities; and to repeal the original

 sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 2-2315, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 2-2315 (1) The purchaser, at the time of settlement
- 4 therefor, shall deduct the wheat excise tax as provided in section
- 5 2-2311 and shall maintain the necessary record of the excise
- 6 tax for each purchase of wheat on the grain settlement form or
- 7 check stub showing payment to the grower for each purchase. Such
- 8 records maintained by the purchaser shall provide the following
- 9 information: (a) Name and address of the grower and seller; (b)
- 10 the date of the purchase; (c) the number of bushels of wheat sold;
- 11 and (d) the amount of wheat excise tax collected on each purchase.
- 12 Such records shall be open for inspection and audit by authorized
- 13 representatives of the board during normal business hours observed
- 14 by the purchaser.
- 15 (2) The purchaser shall render and have on file with the
- 16 board by the last day of each January, April, July, and October, on
- 17 forms prescribed by the board, a statement of the number of bushels
- 18 of wheat purchased in Nebraska. At the time the statement is filed,
- 19 the purchaser shall pay and remit to the board the tax as provided
- 20 for in section 2-2311.
- 21 (3) Five percent of the excise tax collected under
- 22 this section may be retained by the first purchaser to reimburse
- 23 expenses incurred by the first purchaser in collecting the excise
- 24 tax. The board shall adopt and promulgate rules and regulations
- 25 prescribing the procedure, including record keeping and reporting,

- 1 for retaining such funds.
- 2 Sec. 2. Section 2-3631, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 3 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 4 2-3631 (1) The purchaser, at the time of settlement,
- 5 shall deduct the corn fee and shall maintain the necessary record
- 6 of the fee for each purchase of corn on the grain settlement form
- 7 or check stub showing payment to the grower for each purchase. Such
- 8 records maintained by the purchaser shall provide the following
- 9 information:
- 10 (a) Name and address of the grower and seller;
- 11 (b) The date of the purchase;
- 12 (c) The number of bushels of corn sold; and
- (d) The amount of fees collected on each purchase.
- 14 Such records shall be open for inspection during normal
- 15 business hours observed by the purchaser.
- 16 (2) The purchaser shall render and have on file with the
- 17 board by the last day of each January, April, July, and October, on
- 18 forms prescribed by the board, a statement of the number of bushels
- 19 of corn purchased in Nebraska. At the time the statement is filed,
- 20 the purchaser shall pay and remit to the board the fee as provided
- 21 for in section 2-3623.
- 22 (3) Five percent of the fees collected under this section
- 23 may be retained by the first purchaser to reimburse expenses
- 24 incurred by the first purchaser in collecting the fees. The board
- 25 shall adopt and promulgate rules and regulations prescribing the

- 3 Sec. 3. Section 2-4016, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 4 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 5 2-4016 (1) The purchaser, at the time of settlement,
- 6 shall deduct the grain sorghum fee and shall maintain the necessary
- 7 record of the fee for each purchase of grain sorghum on the
- 8 grain settlement form or check stub showing payment to the grower
- 9 for each purchase. Such records maintained by the purchaser shall
- 10 provide the following information: (a) Name and address of the
- 11 grower and seller; (b) the date of the purchase; (c) the number
- 12 of hundredweights of grain sorghum sold; and (d) the amount of
- 13 fees collected on each purchase. Such records shall be open for
- 14 inspection during normal business hours observed by the purchaser.
- 15 (2) The purchaser shall render and have on file with
- 16 the board by the last day of each January, April, July, and
- 17 October, on forms prescribed by the board, a statement of the
- 18 number of hundredweights of grain sorghum purchased in Nebraska
- 19 during the preceding quarter. At the time the statement is filed,
- 20 the purchaser shall pay and remit to the board the fee as provided
- 21 for in section 2-4012.
- 22 (3) Five percent of the fees collected under this section
- 23 may be retained by the first purchaser to reimburse expenses
- 24 incurred by the first purchaser in collecting the fees. The board
- 25 shall adopt and promulgate rules and regulations prescribing the

1 procedure, including record keeping and reporting, for retaining

- 2 such funds.

- 4 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
