- FOR AN ACT relating to electric lines; to amend section 70-311,

 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to extend the

 distance and time requirements relating to notice of

 certain road construction; to provide notice requirements

 for natural resource districts for certain road

 construction; and to repeal the original section.
- Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 70-311, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 70-311 (1) Whenever any county or township road
- 4 construction, widening, repair, or grading project or any road
- 5 <u>ditch improvement project</u> requires, or can reasonably be expected
- 6 to require, the performance of any work within six ten feet of
- 7 any electric transmission or electric distribution line, poles, or
- 8 anchors, notice to the owner of such line, poles, or anchors shall
- 9 be given by the respective county or township officers in charge
- 10 of such projects. Such notice shall be given at least thirty one
- 11 hundred eighty days prior to the start of any work when, because
- 12 of road construction, widening, repair, or grading or road ditch
- 13 improvement project, or for any other reason, it is necessary
- 14 to relocate such line, poles, or anchors or if such work will
- 15 compromise the structural integrity of the line, poles, or anchors.
- 16 If the line, poles, or anchors to be moved are within an area that
- 17 will require Federal Aviation Administration approval, notice shall
- 18 be given at least one year prior to the start of any work.
- 19 (2) If a natural resources district will be altering a
- 20 road structure or grading or moving earth for a flood control,
- 21 recreation, or other project that requires, or can reasonably be
- 22 expected to require, the performance of any work within ten feet of
- 23 any electric transmission or electric distribution line, poles, or
- 24 anchors, notice to the owner of such line, poles, or anchors shall
- 25 be given by the respective natural resources district in charge

1 of such projects. Such notice shall be given at least one hundred

- 2 eighty days prior to the start of any work when, because of such
- 3 road structure alteration or grading or moving earth, or for any
- 4 other reason, it is necessary to relocate such line, poles, or
- 5 anchors or if such work will compromise the structural integrity
- 6 of the line, poles, or anchors. If the line, poles, or anchors
- 7 to be moved are within an area that will require Federal Aviation
- 8 Administration approval, notice shall be given at least one year
- 9 prior to the start of any work.
