1	FOR	AN	ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend sections
2			60-471, 60-501, 60-520, 60-547, and 60-638, Reissue
3			Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and sections 60-101,
4			60-102, 60-136, 60-301, 60-339, 60-4,126, 60-601, and
5			60-605, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2008; to
6			authorize the operation of minitrucks on public highways
7			as prescribed; to define terms; to harmonize provisions;
8			and to repeal the original sections.

9 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 16 inches or less in width, (3) has a dry weight of four thousand
- 17 two hundred pounds or less, (4) travels on four or more tires,

- 23 state if the applicant for such farm permit furnishes satisfactory

- 17 use of a motor vehicle owned by him or her in this state;
- 18 (7) (8) Operator means every person who is in actual
- 19 physical control of a motor vehicle;
- 20 (8) <u>(9)</u> Owner means a person who holds the legal title of
- 21 a motor vehicle, or in the event (a) a motor vehicle is the subject
- 22 of an agreement for the conditional sale or lease thereof with the
- 23 right of purchase upon performance of the conditions stated in the
- 24 agreement and with an immediate right of possession vested in the
- 25 conditional vendee or lessee or (b) a mortgagor of a vehicle is

1 entitled to possession, then such conditional vendee or lessee or

- 2 mortgagor shall be deemed the owner for the purposes of the act;

- 4 partnership, limited liability company, association, or
- 5 corporation;
- 6 (10) Proof of financial responsibility means
- 7 evidence of ability to respond in damages for liability, on account
- 8 of accidents occurring subsequent to the effective date of such
- 9 proof, arising out of the ownership, maintenance, or use of a
- 10 motor vehicle, (a) in the amount of twenty-five thousand dollars
- 11 because of bodily injury to or death of one person in any one
- 12 accident, (b) subject to such limit for one person, in the amount
- 13 of fifty thousand dollars because of bodily injury to or death of
- 14 two or more persons in any one accident, and (c) in the amount of
