A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to insurance; to amend section 44-2835, Revised

 Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2008; to change certain

 reporting provisions under the Nebraska Hospital-Medical

 Liability Act; and to repeal the original section.
- Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 44-2835, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2008, is amended to read:
- 3 44-2835 (1) Each malpractice claim settled or adjudicated
- 4 to final judgment against a health care provider under the Nebraska
- 5 Hospital-Medical Liability Act shall be reported to the director
- 6 by the plaintiff's attorney and by the health care provider or his
- 7 or her insurer or risk manager within sixty days following final
- 8 disposition of the claim. Such report to the director shall state
- 9 the following:
- 10 (a) The nature of the claim and the name and address
- 11 of the health care provider who rendered the service that is the
- 12 subject of the claim;
- 13 (b) The alleged injury and the damages asserted;
- 14 (c) Attorney's fees and expenses incurred in connection
- 15 with the claim or defense; and
- 16 (d) The amount of any settlement or judgment.
- 17 (2) The director shall forward the name of every health
- 18 care provider, except a hospital, against whom a settlement has
- 19 been made or judgment has been rendered under the act to the
- 20 Department of Health and Human Services for such action, if any, as
- 21 it deems to be appropriate under the circumstances.
- 22 (3) Beginning January 1, 2011, and annually thereafter,
- 23 the Department of Health and Human Services shall collate and
- 24 report the data received under subsection (2) of this section
- 25 to the Clerk of the Legislature and to the chairpersons of
