A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to courts; to amend sections 25-2705 and 25-2805, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to trial by jury; to harmonize provisions; to provide an operative date; and to repeal the original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 25-2705, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 25-2705 Either party to any case in county court, except
- 4 criminal cases arising for which the maximum sentence is less
- 5 than six months imprisonment and which arise under city or village
- 6 ordinances, traffic infractions, or other infractions, and any
- 7 matter arising under the Nebraska Probate Code or the Nebraska
- 8 Uniform Trust Code, may demand a trial by jury. In civil cases,
- 9 the demand shall be in writing and shall be filed on or before
- 10 answer day except as otherwise provided in section 25-2805. with
- 11 the court:
- 12 (1) By a plaintiff on the date the complaint is filed
- 13 with the court;
- 14 (2) By a defendant on or before the date the answer is
- 15 filed with the court;
- 16 (3) By a counterclaimant on the date the counterclaim is
- 17 filed with the court;
- 18 (4) By a counterclaim defendant on or before the date the
- 19 reply to the counterclaim is filed with the court;
- 20 (5) By a third-party plaintiff on the date the
- 21 third-party complaint is filed with the court;
- 22 (6) By a third-party defendant on or before the date the
- 23 answer to the third-party complaint is filed with the court;
- 24 (7) By a cross-claimant on the date the cross-claim is
- 25 <u>filed with the court; or</u>

1 (8) By a cross-claim defendant on or before the date the

- 2 answer to the cross claim is filed with the court.
- 3 All provisions of law relating to juries in the district
- 4 courts shall apply to juries in the county courts, and the district
- 5 court jury list shall be used, except that juries in the county
- 6 courts shall consist of six persons.
- 7 Sec. 2. Section 25-2805, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 8 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 9 25-2805 All matters in the Small Claims Court shall be
- 10 tried to the court without a jury. Except as provided in section
- 11 25-2618.01, any defendant in an action or such defendant's attorney
- 12 may transfer the case to the regular docket of the county court
- 13 by giving notice to the court at least two days prior to the time
- 14 set for the hearing. Upon such notice the case shall be transferred
- 15 to the regular docket of the county court. At the same time as
- 16 such notice is given to transfer the case, any defendant or such
- 17 defendant's attorney may demand trial by jury, and the Small Claims
- 18 Court shall forward the demand to the county court. The party
- 19 causing the transfer of a case from the Small Claims Court to the
- 20 regular docket shall pay as a fee the difference between the fee
- 21 for filing a claim in Small Claims Court and the fee for filing a
- 22 claim on the regular docket.
- 23 In any action transferred to the regular docket there
- 24 shall be no further pleadings, motions challenging pleadings, or
- 25 discovery unless ordered by the court upon a showing that any such

1 procedure is necessary to the prompt and just determination of the

- 2 action. In any action transferred to the regular docket a defendant
- 3 shall file an answer. Any jury demand in cases transferred from
- 4 Small Claims Court to county court shall be made within the
- 5 timeframes provided in section 25-2705.
- 6 Sec. 3. This act becomes operative on January 1, 2011.
- 7 Sec. 4. Original sections 25-2705 and 25-2805, Reissue
- 8 Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
